Topic – Learning a New Song

- 1 – www.youtube.com The Grand Daddy of all song video/audio files. Has the ability to slow down the pitch of the song. Can not transpose.
- 2 - www.ultimate-guitar.com/ Search for Tabulature, Chords, lyrics, arrangements. Can also Transpose to other Keys. Can create a Karaoke type playback and can isolate instruments.
- 3 - www.azlyrics.com/ A resource for Lyrics. Select the ones you want.
- 4 – www.chordify.net/ Love this one. It detects the chords from a song and also can transpose and show Capo options.
- 5 - www.ronimusic.com/ Slows music and changes Pitch of a recording. Can isolate and loop portions of a song.
- 6 – www.strummachine.com/ A virtual band that you can practice with. Can change Keys and Tempo. No lyrics. Just backing music “Strums”.
- 7 – www.Loop2Learn.com Loop Videos from Youtube or your own – Change the tempo without changing the pitch. Select just a portion of the song to work on. Great for learning by ear.
- 8 – www.clipgrab.org Can download and save video and audio files for offline editing and learning.
